Data collected from the submitted survey will be retained indefinitely on password-protected and encrypted computers or USB keys, to which only researchers associated with this research have to access. The data on this server will be accessible to all researchers except that Dr. Celine Latulipe, who is the instructor for the course will not get access to the raw, anonymous data until after the grade amendment period has passed (January 2021). Downloaded survey results will be stored on the investigator's password protected laptops in password-protected files. The survey data will be kept indefinitely. After 3 years, it will be archived on an encrypted USB key and stored. The laptops belong to the investigators and are password protected and also full-volume encrypted. The password-protected and encrypted files will be sent between the investigators through the university email system.
